Despite being one of the top athletes in her high school, she was frequently bullied and struggled with depression. She has turned that life experience into the basis for her platform speaking out against depression, suicide, and bullying.

Advocates for Youth

Established in 1980, Advocates for Youth champions efforts that help young people make informed and responsible decisions about their reproductive and sexual health. Advocates' has developed a number of educational programs targeting young people ages 12-18 that contains a wide variety of lesson plans divided into specific topics and issues.

"Be Proud! Be Responsible! A Safer Sex Curriculum" is an Advocates' program developed to prevent teen pregnancy, HIV, and sexually transmitted infections (STI's). This program is a five-hour, six-part intervention appropriate for inner city youth ages 13 to 18. In small groups of six to 12, a trained educator engages the participants in experiential activities, games, and role-playing to encourage learning and participation.

"Be Proud! Be Responsible! A Safer Sex Curriculum" topics include:

- Pregnancy Prevention
- Avoiding Risky Situations
- Proper condom use
- Risks of injected drug use
- Unsafe sexual behaviors

"Be Proud! Be Responsible! A Safer Sex Curriculum" builds young people's sense of community and addresses the importance of protecting one's community, as well as oneself, against the potentially negative consequences of unprotected sexual intercourse. The curriculum emphasizes that it feels good to make proud and responsible safer sex decisions.
